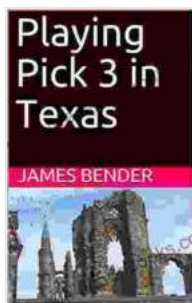

10	J	Q	K	A	<b>Royal Flush</b> Nothing beats a royal flush. This is the best hand in poker and it's very rare. This is a straight flush from 10 to Ace.
5	6	7	8	9	<b>Straight Flush</b> The second best hand. Just like a straight, but the cards are all the same suit. Like in this example, all consecutive spades.
A	A	A	A	2	<b>Four of a kind</b> As the name says, this is four of the same cards. The hand is completed with the highest card on the table or in your hand.
A	A	A	K	K	<b>Full House</b> A combination of three of a kind with a pair. The full house hand that has the highest three of a kind cards wins from other full houses.
2	4	6	8	K	<b>Flush</b> Five cards that are all the same suit. These don't need to be in any order. If two players have a flush, the player with the highest card in the flush wins.
5	6	7	8	9	<b>Straight</b> A series of five cards that follow each other, but that are not of the same suit. Aces can follow a king, or start a straight followed by a two.
A	A	A	2	7	<b>Three of a kind</b> Three cards of the same kind, for example three aces. The hand is completed with the two highest cards that are available.
K	K	Q	Q	J	<b>Two pair</b> Two sets of two cards of the same kind. For example two kings and two queens. The best hand to complete the hand is the highest card that is left available.
A	A	9	8	7	<b>Pair</b> Two cards of the same kind, for example two aces. The hand is filled up with the three highest cards that are left available.
A	8	6	4	2	<b>High card</b> You have none of the above and only a single card, like the ace in this example. Maybe it's time to fold!

The betting round occurring after another card is dealt on the table after the flop, turning the total amount of cards on hand to be six.



**RIVER**  
Is the ultimate betting round before all cards are to be judged.



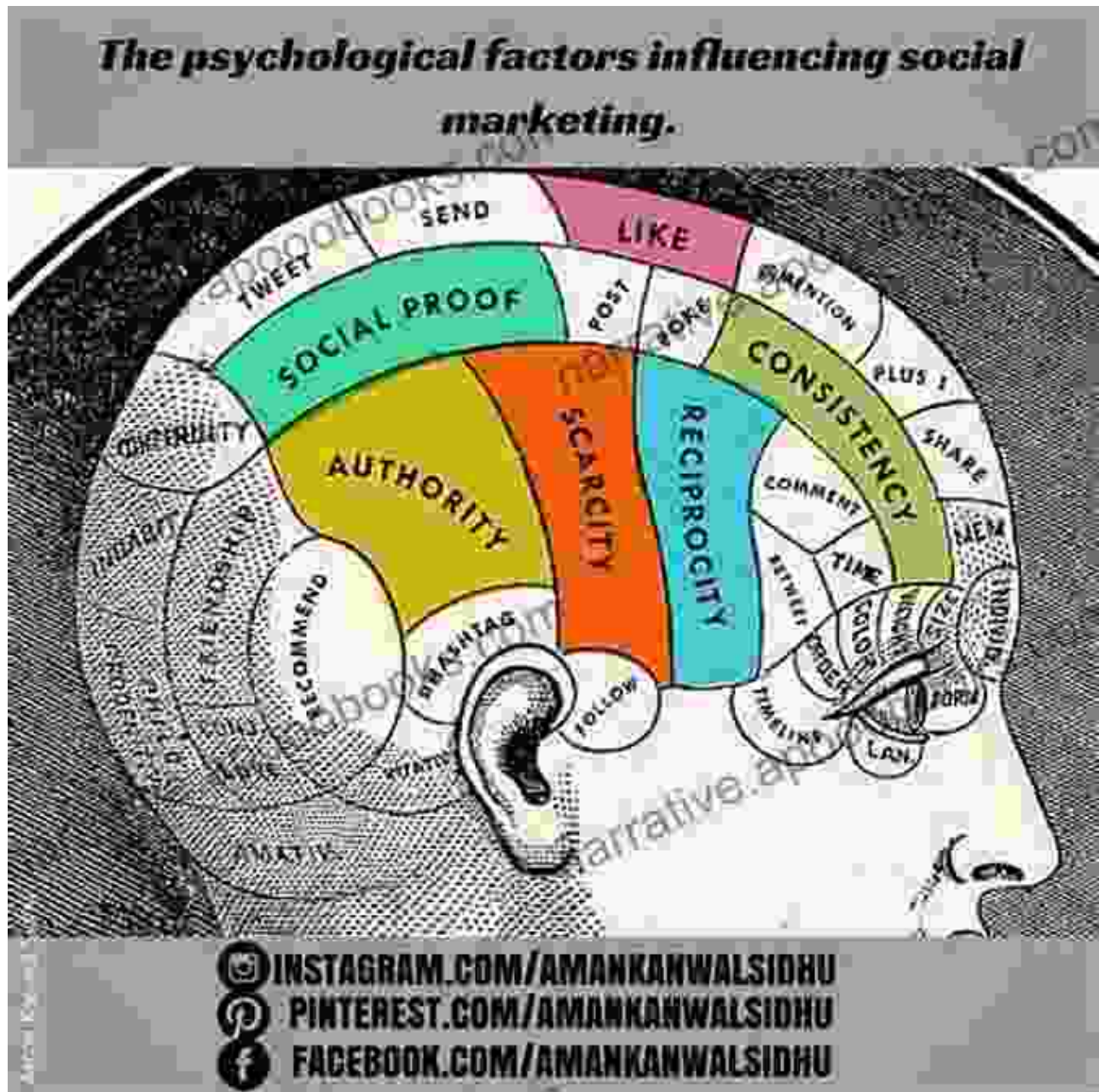
**SHOWDOWN**  
All cards from all active players are shown on the table and the player with the highest hand wins the entire pot.

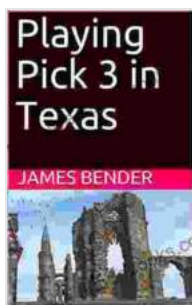

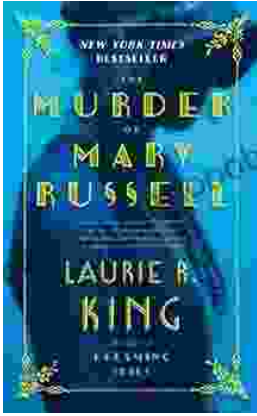
