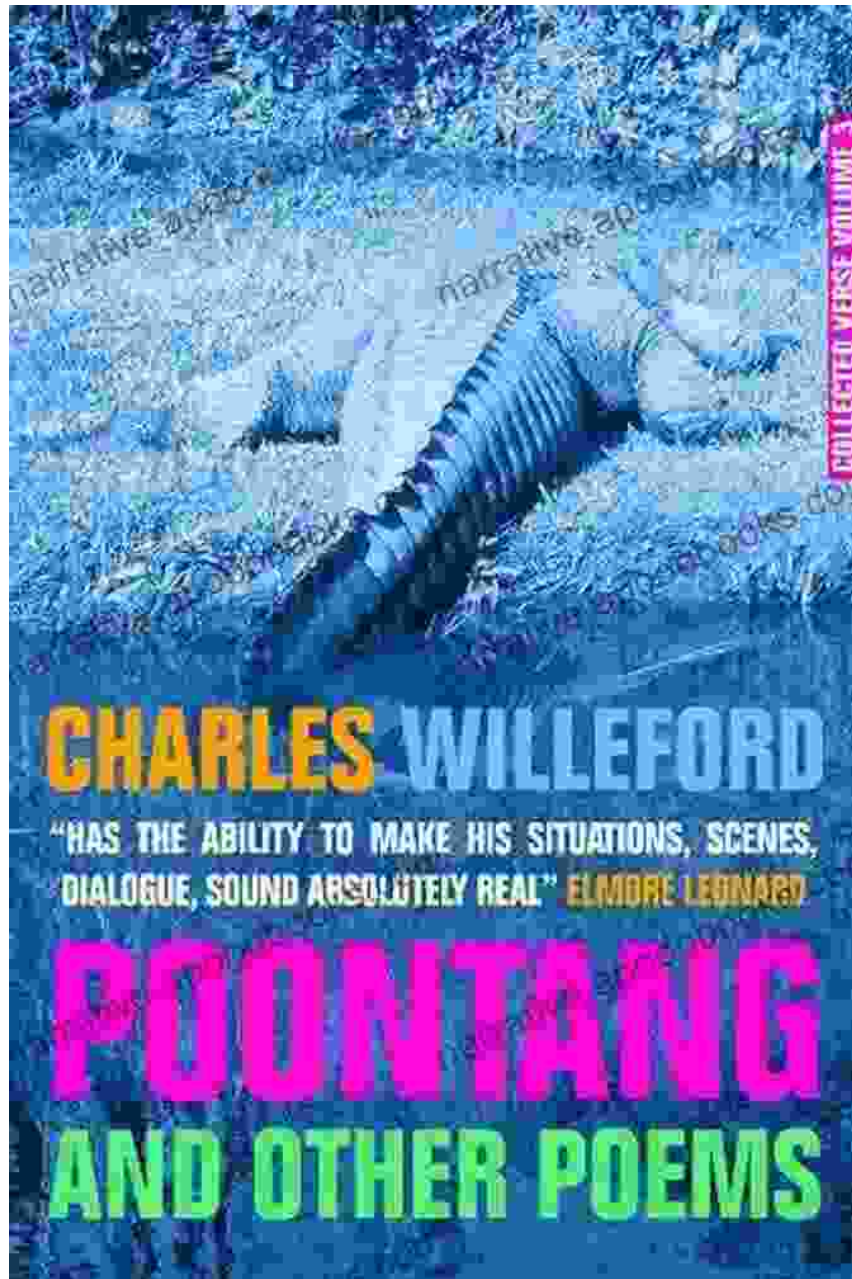


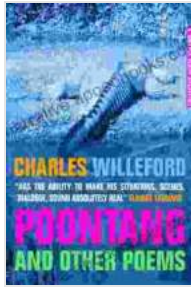

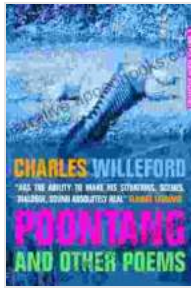
About the Author

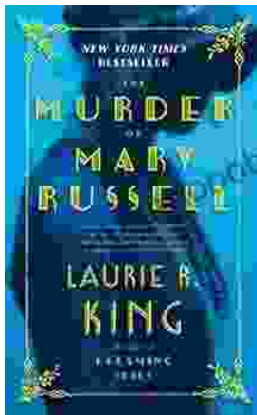
