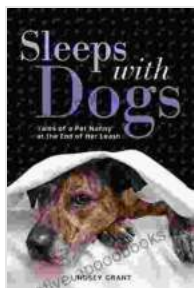

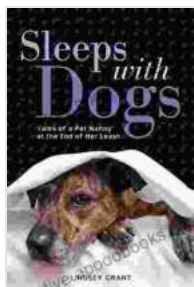
I was so relieved that I had finally given Mittens a bath. Her fur was clean and soft, and she looked much happier.
