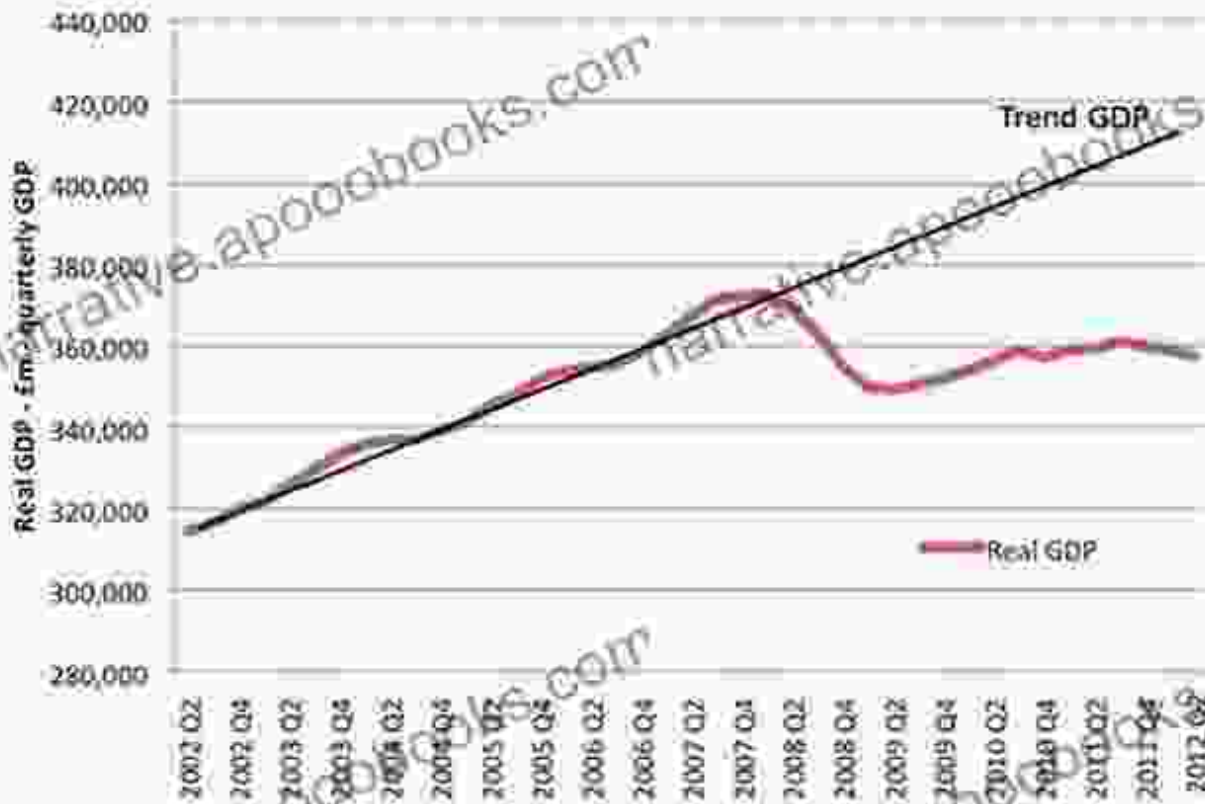

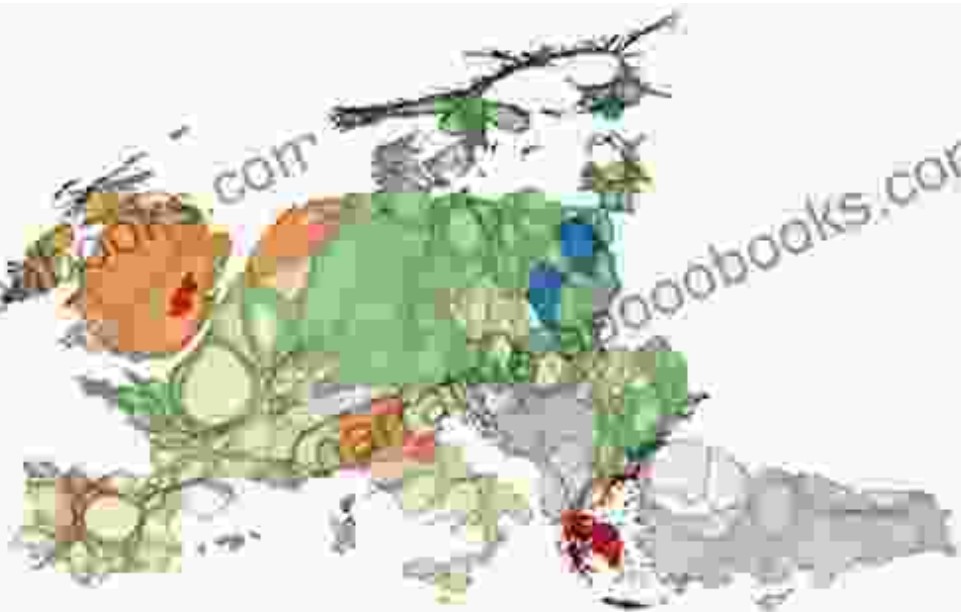

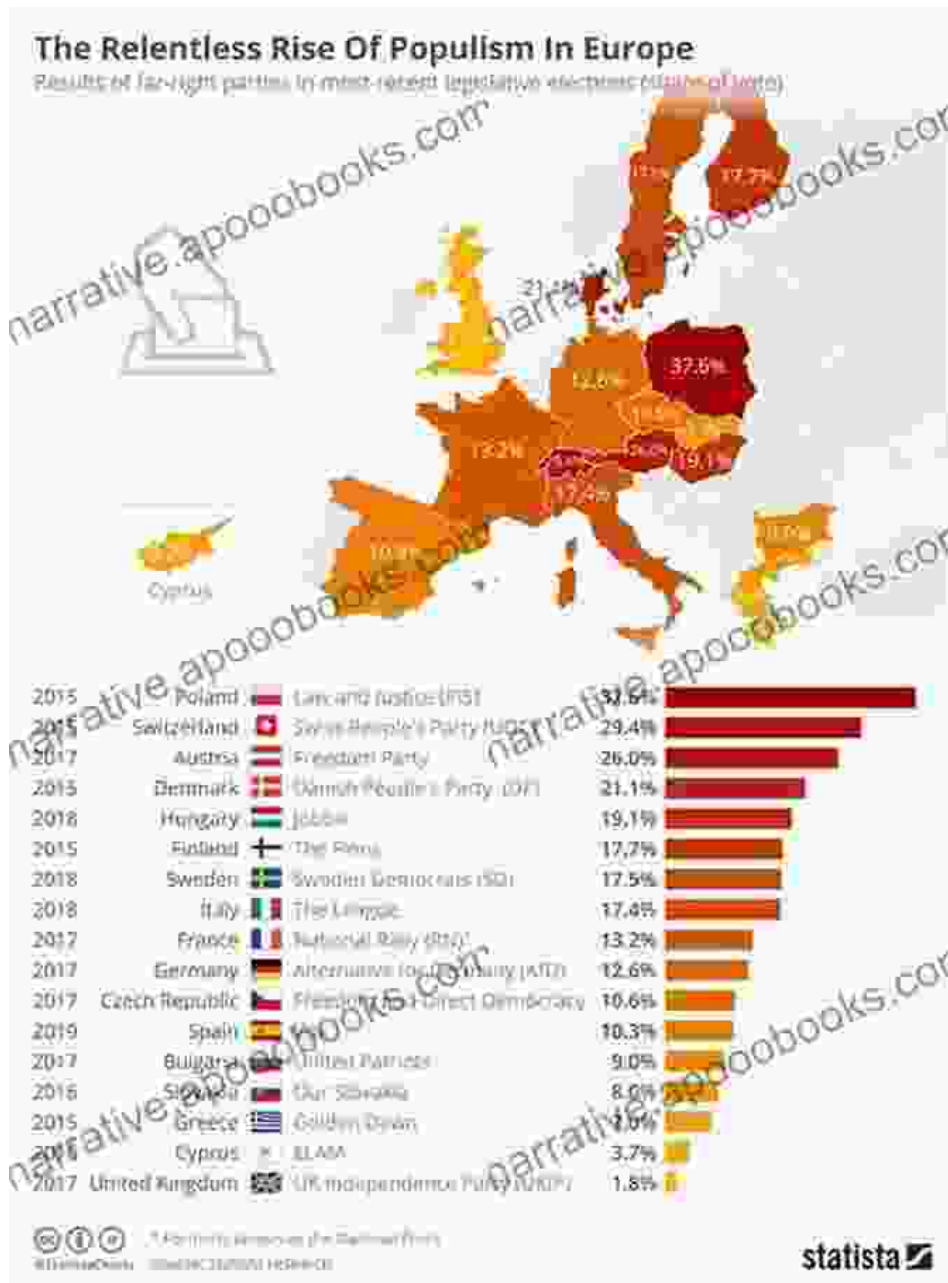
Real GDP

Change in Household Disposable Income 2007-2011



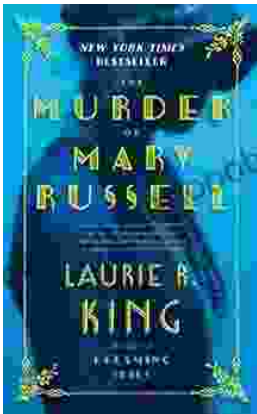
